Grande Day Parade Route

Sunday, June 26th at 2:00 PM

Pre-Registered Line-Up starts at 1:00 PM (NO EARLIER)
Please ENTER ONLY at one of the 2 starred entrance points - all registrants MUST check in with their unit line-up number

Pre-registered Line-Up Check In: Enter on 13th Ave from Hwy 12 (6th Street) if coming from downtown or South of Hwd Lk

Pre-registered Line-Up Check In: Enter by water tower if coming from North of Hwd Lk

PARADE ROUTE - Starts by Memorial Park, heads South on City Rd 6, crosses Hwy 12 (6th Street). After Troubles (10th Ave.)... goes down 7th Street, then to 9th Avenue, onto 9th Street, onto 11th Ave., back on 7th Street, turn up 12th Ave., to 8th Street and then onto 13th Ave. and ends near the Fairground RR tracks.
